

How To Make Oversized 20" Bows

To keep assembly time to a minimum, gather the materials and read through the instructions before beginning.

Materials:

1 Roll of #40 Qualatex MasterBow® Ribbon
Qualatex® BalloonRibbon™

Instructions:

1. Make a 10" bow, but **don't cut a notch in the center.** Instead, remove the bow loops from the ribbon arms on the Qualatex MasterBow maker. Insert one side of the loop into the cutting head, and cut a notch where the two ends overlap. Repeat to make another 10" bow with the same ribbon.



2. Tie the bows together at the notched areas using Qualatex BalloonRibbon.



- 3.** Carefully fluff the 10" bows as you would a normal bow.
4. Make one 16" bow using the same ribbon, notching and fluffing as normal.
5. Tie the 16" bow into the center of the two 10" bows.



TIPS

- Sell these giant bows to car dealerships and appliance stores. Any business that sells oversized items which are difficult to gift wrap will appreciate this added touch for customers.
- Depending on the type of ribbon used, you may be able to reduce the number of turns required for 10" bows on the Qualatex MasterBow maker. Experiment with different ribbon types since thicker ribbons, such as Velour, require fewer total loops.
