

How To Fluff A Bow

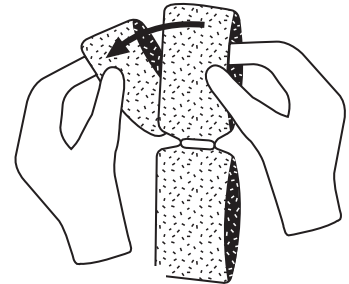
Holding the unfluffed bow vertically with the BalloonRibbon knot and bow tails away from you.



The BalloonRibbon knot is facing away from you.

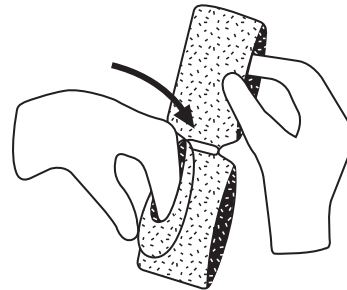

Holding the upper loops of the bow with your right hand, pull out the innermost loop with your left hand approximately 2" (5cm) to the left (into a 10 o'clock position.)

Keeping the loop in your left hand taut, twist the loop 1/2 turn clockwise while pulling it down toward you and the middle notch. (For best results - keep the loop taut and **make sure the loop "clears" the middle notch.**)*



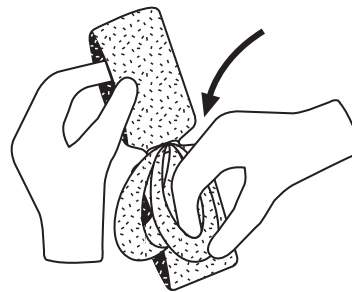

Now hold the upper loops of the bow in your left hand. Pull out the innermost loop with your right hand, approximately 2" (5 cm) to the right (into the 2 o'clock position.)*

Keeping the loop in your right hand taut, twist the loop 1/2 turn counter-clockwise while pulling it down toward you and the middle notch. **Make sure the loop "clears" the middle notch.**



Note

For two-color or three color bows, repeat steps 2 & 3 for each color **before** switching hands.

Repeat steps 2 through 5 until all upper loops have been pulled and twisted.

Rotate bow 180 degrees, keeping the BalloonRibbon knot facing away from you.

Repeat steps 2 through 5 until all lower loops are separated, pulled, and twisted.

You may now "primp" the bow as you wish into a pleasing shape.
